1. General Information

MUQADDAS X invites scholars, researchers, and postgraduate students to submit original and unpublished scholarly papers in the field of Quranic Studies. Submissions must not be under consideration elsewhere. The official languages for the publications are **English** or **Arabic**.

Subtheme 6: Arabic Language Alignment and Qur'anic Comprehension through AI Technologies

Subtheme 7: Future Solutions: Towards the Development of Shariah-Compliant and Qur'anic Value-Based AI Technologies

Subtheme 8: The Role of AI in Ethical Governance of the Muslim Ummah: Qur'an-Based Opportunities and Risks

Subtheme 9: Utilization of AI in the Preservation and Protection of Islamic Historical Sources

Subtheme 10: Artificial Intelligence and the Preservation of Islamic Creed ('Aqidah) in the Digital Qur'anic Era

Submission requires a title, author's full name, alongside with full address (institution's or university's address, e-mail, phone number, office's number, and fax) in a separate sheet.

Length: 250–300 words

Language: English or Arabic

Content: background, objectives, methodology, and key findings

Keywords: 5 keywords

5. Full Paper Guidelines

Length: 4,000–6,000 words (including references)

Format: Microsoft Word (.doc/.docx)

Font:

English: Times New Roman, 12 pt

Arabic: Traditional Arabic, 16 pt

Line spacing: 1.5

Margins: 1 inch on all sides

Alignment & Indentations : Justified
